Al via la presidenza di **Domenico Parisi** all'ANPAL - l'Agenzia Nazionale per le politiche Attive per il Lavoro - e al contestuale incarico di Amministratore Unico di Anpal Servizi SpA.. Con la firma al decreto di nomina del presidente della Repubblica Sergio Mattarella, si era concluso il 4 febbraio scorso l'iter di nomina del nuovo presidente dell'Anpal. Domenico Parisi, detto Mimmo, entra nel pieno delle sue funzioni a seguito della trasmissione del nulla osta da parte della Corte dei Conti (Ufficio Controllo Atti P.C.M., 25 febbraio 2019).



Il professor Parisi, dopo essersi laureato nel 1992 all'Università Cattolica di Milano in Sociologia, si trasferisce in America dove continua a studiare, frequentando un Master di specializzazione alla Pennsylvania State University e conseguendo successivamente presso la stessa università il Dottorato di ricerca in "Rural Sociology" nel 1998. Continua dunque la carriera accademica fino ad arrivare nel Mississippi, a Starkville, dove ha sede la Mississippi State University, dove diventa professore ordinario nel 2007 di Demografia e Statistica applicata. È in questo Stato che il professor Parisi diventa direttore del Centro nazionale di ricerca strategica di pianificazione e analisi (nSPARC) e mette a punto il Mississippi works system, un modo innovativo di intendere i servizi per il lavoro utilizzando anche i big data, con tutte le informazioni statali e delle aziende, un sistema che consente alle persone in cerca di occupazione di entrare in contatto diretto, ancorché mediato, con la domanda di lavoro. Determinante per il sistema realizzato è il legame tra la persona, la sua formazione e la domanda di lavoro delle imprese, nella consapevolezza che l'aggiornamento professionale e la valorizzazione delle competenze siano il primo passo necessario per trovare occupazione. Il professor Parisi è stato nominato dal Governo in Anpal per la sua esperienza, per il fondamentale ruolo che l'Agenzia nazionale avrà nella gestione e implementazione del Reddito di Cittadinanza: sia per la realizzazione delle piattaforme informatiche necessarie, in concorso con INPS, Poste e gli enti coinvolti; sia per la guida delle risorse che saranno contrattualizzate da Anpal Servizi in supporto e in accordo con le Regioni, per la promozione e gestione sul territorio dei servizi per il lavoro e il funzionamento dei Centri per l'impiego.

Improve the image of the state across the country and throughout the world through the use of data and scientific research.

Major Accomplishments:

Designed, developed, and implemented legislation for the establishment of a statewide board for the promotion and implementation of data-driven policies.

Major contributor in the recruitment of new business and industry and the expansion of existing industry across the state including Yokohama that will bring 2000 good jobs to the state, and Ingles Shipbuilding.

Director, National Strategic Planning & Analysis Research Center, 2007-present.

nSPARC is nationally and internationally recognized for expanding the role of the university in society. It is a university-level research center at Mississippi State University (MSU). nSPARC provides an intellectual, interdisciplinary hub for promoting research and scholarship aimed at addressing complex social and economic issues. It formulates and implements big data, big picture solutions for a wide variety of constituencies, including state, federal, private, and international entities and programs. The center has a dual vision to (1) provide an administrative and intellectual bridge between colleges, departments, and centers in support of activities that facilitate multidisciplinary, translational, and policy research in socioeconomic development; and (2) engage the university with state, regional, national, and international economic, social, and public entities.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

The director is charged with working with state and local organizations to integrate education and workforce activities. In this capacity, the director oversees and manages activities with more than 200 state and local organizations, including the Governor's Office and other government entities.

The director acts as the ambassador of the center and, in this capacity, works with the president, executive vice president and provost, vice presidents, and faculty senate representatives to fulfill the university-wide vision and mission in research, teaching, service, and engagement.

The director oversees and manages an annual budget of more than \$6 million in research activities and a staff of more than 70 individuals, with the assistance of a deputy director, associate director, and six assistant directors.

The director works very closely with the Office of Sponsored Programs and Accounting to facilitate pre- and post-award activities and with the Institutional Review Board (IRB) to ensure that all research projects are in compliance with human subject guidelines.

The director coordinates activities with the Office of Legal Council and the Office of Technology and Commercialization, particularly in the areas of intellectual property and knowledge transfer.

The director hires new research faculty and scientists and maintains a relationship with the Human Resources department to ensure that the center follows appropriate hiring practices and procedures, as well as to ensure effective personnel management.

The director develops and maintains sustainable partnerships with deans, department heads, faculty, and students.

The director mentors young junior faculty and upcoming scholars and prepares new leadership for the expansion and sustainability of research and service programs for the university and the state as a whole.

The director represents the university and the state with stakeholders in the state, region, nation, and world.

Major Accomplishments:

Raised approximately \$50 million in grants and contracts, significantly contributing to MSU's national and international recognition in education and workforce development.

Designed, implemented, and wrote the grant for Mississippi LifeTracks, the state longitudinal data system.

Created the SWIB's 10-year strategic plan, "Mississippi 2020 Vision: Working Together," aimed at improving education and workforce outcomes (<http://www.swib.ms.gov/StrategicPlan/>), with significant input from local and state stakeholders.

Developed and established two research facilities: a \$1 million polling center for government and business development and a \$2.2 million data center for big data, big picture solutions.

Improved and expanded university engagement with the public, state government, and business community.

Provided support and assistance to attract and establish new businesses in Mississippi, including Toyota.

Developed an industry-government partnership for economic development that assists more than 10,000 businesses in Mississippi each year.

Secured funding for several major statewide initiatives, including \$10 million for the development and implementation of the State Longitudinal Data System, which has become a model for the nation (<http://nces.ed.gov/programs/slids/publications.asp>).

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

Supervised a group of 10 scientists engaged in labor force research and mentor several undergraduate and graduate students, and secured resources to support the overall vision of the unit and the center.

Accomplishments:

Assisted in the development of SWIB's five-year strategic plan, with significant input from local and state stakeholders.

Secured more than \$2 million in research funds and provided support for nine graduate students.

Developed state-of-the-art cyber-infrastructure to support the unit's research, making it one of the most productive and successful research units on campus.

Co-Coordinator, Unit for Community and Environmental Studies, 1998-2003.

The focus of the unit was to promote community and environmental studies at Mississippi State.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

The primary responsibility was to work with the coordinator and senior faculty to reinvigorate the rural community development program at Mississippi State, originally established in the 1960s.

Accomplishments:

Rural community development became and continues to be one of the signature areas of distinction at MSU. The university also enjoys a national reputation for examining the urban-rural interface. I also secured a competitive grant from the National Research Initiative for a total of \$250,000. The project was ranked No.1 in the country. I also established partnerships with other national organizations and academic units involved in rural development.
